### NEONATOLOGY COURSE – Chaux-d'Abel (Jura) 2021

Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6 p.m. – Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2 p.m.

#### Objectives

This course aims particularly those participants who wish to expand their knowledge in the field of perinatal medicine, in respiratory support and in leadership. Like the two other courses, this seminar offers state-of-the-art interactive teaching on key topics. Teaching will be evidence based, clinically and practically oriented, and more importantly, will be 'inspiring'.

Additionally, this 'third' course will offer an interactive workshop on research, covering aspects such as planning and preparing a research project, obtaining grants, and conducting the research itself.

For all neo4neo courses, establishing a close relationship between trainers and trainees remains an important focus. As such, it may spin off future clinical and scientific collaboration in the field of perinatal medicine in Switzerland.

#### Registration Fee

**Around 900 CHF per participant.** This fee includes full pension for 3 days, course material and 'extras' such as diner at social evening, gifts for the speakers etc., and the full pension for Riccardo, Mathias and Jean-Claude, as well as a total coverage fee for the external teachers (300 CHF per person).

#### Expectations of Participants

- **Each participant is expected to attend the course from the beginning Wednesday evening to the end, Saturday around 16h. Please do not enrol if you cannot attend the full course!**
- Each participant is expected to summarize one half-day sessions for all other participants. Participants are welcome to present research work they are planning or already conducting (20' time inclusive questions and discussion; as slides, on flip chart).
- For the 2 1/2 days in a retreat, team spirit and active participation are expected for the teaching sessions. Each participant is also expected to contribute to the social happening after work that could include slides, music, games, stories etc.

The course, the speakers and the trainers will be evaluated at end of the course.
