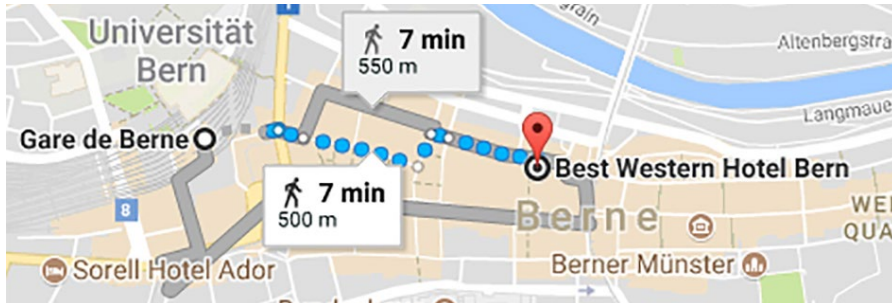


## How to find the congress venue
